55+ Defensive Driving

Improve your driving skills in today's cars on today's roads. Minnesota State Law requires all insurance companies to give a 10% premium reduction on policies of private passenger vehicle insurance to anyone 55 years of age or older that have completed an accident prevention course such as this. After completing your 8-hour introductory course, you will need to complete a 4-hour refresher course every 3rd year to maintain your certificate. CABS: Child and Baby-Sitting Safety Class / American Safety & Health Institute (www.hsi.com)

Learn the responsibilities of being a prepared, safe, responsible and professional babysitter. Topics include starting your own babysitting business, child development, behavior guidance, supervision, proper feeding & diapering techniques, personal safety, medical emergencies, basic first aid care and fire safety. Instructor provides baby dolls, bottles, diaper supplies for hands-on participation skills. The course is developed by the American Safety and Health Institute and approved by the American Pediatrics Association. Class participants receive a CABS book and ASHI certification card. Early Childhood Family Education For Fulda Area Families

ECFE is a program for birth to age 5 children and families. It is a chance to participate in activities facilitated by a licensed Early Childhood Teacher and also for parents to meet with a licensed Parent Educator and other parents of young children. ECFE meets one time per week for 1.5 hours. There will be many age appropriate activities for you to do with your child. ECFE promotes cognitive, physical, emotional, and social development. We work with the children, their families, and the community. We will be offering our ECFE classes at the **Elementary School starting on Monday, February 4th, 2019** for an 8 week session in the fall.

What are the benefits of ECFE?

Encourages positive parental interactions that impact how children develop and learn.

Research shows that ECFE programs involving parents with their children are more effective than programs focusing exclusively on children.

Children whose parents are involved in their early education are more likely to be successful in school.

Why attend ECFE?

Parents meet to share support, experiences, and information about child development and parenting techniques.

Through a variety of ECFE classroom activities, children view themselves as competent learners and practice social skills as they demonstrate making friends, solving conflicts and functioning in a group.
